WOUNDED WARRIORS CANADA NATIONAL SERVICE DOG PROGRAM

The Wounded Warriors Canada Service Dog Program will in conjunction with our advisors, identify and approve trainers and schools to train Wounded Warriors Canada PTSD Service Dogs. This ongoing process will monitor those trainers to ensure that they meet or exceed current and pending PTSD Service Dogs standards and laws throughout Canada.

In concrete terms, this will mean that the Wounded Warriors Canada Service Dog Program identifies trainers and schools that fall within the following parameters:

THE PROGRAM PROVIDES A CONSISTENT HISTORY OF TRANSPARENT FINANCIAL ACCOUNTABILITY.

WOUNDED WARRIORS CANADA SERVICE FUNDED DOG PROVIDERS ACROSS THE COUNTRY ARE COMMITTED TO ASSISTING ONE ANOTHER BY WORKING COOPERATIVELY WITH OTHER WOUNDED WARRIOR CANADA FUNDED SERVICE DOG PROVIDERS.
